Completion, Placement & Licensure Rate Disclosures

Per our reporting requirements for the National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts & Sciences (NACCAS) for the latest annual report period of 2016, our institutional disclosure rates are as follows: Completion Rate: 68.75% Employment Rate: 68.18 % Licensure Rate: 100%

Explanations:

1. The completion rate does not show students who may have completed after the reporting period due to an approved medical or personal leave of absence nor does it show those who may have transferred and completed elsewhere, nor does it show those who, due to life situations, had to terminate and return later to complete.
2. The employment rate reflects only the students that notified us of their employment or those we were able to contact. It is likely that other graduates are working, but that we were not made aware of their location. Note: Independence College of Cosmetology provides its students with ongoing placement assistance including, but not limited to, job postings in our Employment Opportunities notebook, listings on our Facebook page and listings on our Bloom.com account. The College hosts a Career Fair twice per year to help current students and graduates become aware of employment opportunities.
3. Graduates who sat for the licensure exam during this reporting period and passed both parts received a professional license. Graduates have the opportunity to take the exam up to three times.

NOTE: Graduates in the Beauty Industry have a wide variety of career opportunities, which may include those listed in the school catalog under each course. Some of these opportunities may require additional training and expertise. Income and the methods of compensation vary widely depending on years of experience, skill level, client base and hours worked.
